Care Home Provider:

Challenge - To communicate with all Key-stakeholders and influencers that are responsible for each of the homes within their group, via an integrated GIS.

Solution - Having been provided with a list of each of the home sites in the group, we were able to identify the relevant Constituencies, MPs and devolved Members responsible for each site. At a Local Government level, we provided the ward councillors and cabinet members responsible for Social Care. For the NHS, CCGs, Secondary Care Trusts and Health Boards we provided the appropriate commissioners. The data was built into a live bespoke feed to be called into the clients own system on demand.

Benefits - The data was immediately available saving time and huge research costs. The information is based upon exact geography for each home, ensuring the correct stakeholder is contacted in each case. The information is also updated daily and so remains accurate throughout the duration of their license.

Water Utility Company:

Challenge - When issues arose with supply, staff members would need to reach out to key-stakeholders as well as the vulnerable within their region quickly and efficiently.

Solution - Based on the area covered by this regional operator we identified all required stakeholders, including Schools, Parish Councils, Local Authorities and MPs with ward, constituency and parish codes delivered via a live XML datafile called via an API into the clients own GIS system.

Benefits - There is no longer a need to interrogate google or search for disparate, decaying datasets as all information is delivered on demand and held centrally. The time saved in reaching vulnerable individuals can save lives and is ultimately priceless.

The following example shows all key organisations and political control for TQ1 1DE, Torquay.


